## VIII. Scott Turners Project

- a. 2505 & 2607 Bluebonnet (in between South Lamar and Del Curto)
- b. Since last meeting, hired architect, addressed parking issue
- c. 3 buildings, 2 buildings 2-story town home style units, buildings in back are flats
- d. 25 foot away from residential lot line for 2 stories
- e. Back building has 3 stories with parking underneath
- f. 18 units total, 12 guest parking spots (2 spaces for 2-3 bedroom units, 1 spot for 1 bedrooms)
- g. Total parking spots 41 (original proposal was 48)
- h. 1 protected tree (smack in the middle so will have to move), no heritage trees
- i. The Palms—going to try and move palm trees that are currently there
- j. Joe Guerrero with city, city has done study on this section, must follow city code to address any potential flooding issues
- k. Benefit to neighborhood, capture water on our site in a pond, will slow down flow and direct to sewer system
- I. Will have some community space for residents
- m. Will be doing sidewalks on Bluebonnet
- n. Flat roofs
- o. Will not block SOLA views
- p. \$300-325k estimate
- q. Just rented house out for a year—building will start in about a year
- r. Current zoning SF3

#### IX. Carol Gibbs. Neighborhood Advisor

- a. City is addressing flooding issue on Del Curto
- b. Driveway construction—flooded condos on opposite side of the street
- Watershed Dept. has committed to study and address many flooding issues in our neighborhood, where a majority of the problems are
- d. Floodwater on your yard beyond what's normal, call 311
- e. West Bouldin Watershed Dept. will have a web site to enter past flood issues for neighbors
- f. Take photographs & videos of flood events with date stamps, can upload these to web site
- g. Sometime in fall, dept. will host meeting for all neighborhoods participating in study
- h. Just a study at this point, no money, no clue what they will do with the study
